

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATIONS FOR CITY OF ROCKS

From Jackson, Wyoming it is about 4 hours to drive to the COR. From JH go to Idaho Falls. At Idaho Falls, take I-15 to Pocatello, at Pocatello and points east, take exit 72, I-86 to Twin Falls. At the I-84 Junction, head South to Tremonton/Ogden. Driving South on I-84 you will quickly take the early exit onto East Yale Road to Malta. Once on Highway 81 head South to Malta. At Malta turn onto Highway 77 to The City of Rocks. While on Highway 77 drive through the Conner Creek Junction stop sign straight ahead to Almo Idaho to the City of Rocks Visitor Center.

From Salt Lake City it is about a 3 hour drive to the COR. From Salt Lake City, take I-15 North. At Tremonton stay on I-84 West. On I-84 you will quickly take exit onto East Yale Road to Malta. Once on Highway 81 head South to Malta. At Malta turn onto Highway 77 to The City of Rocks. While on Highway 77 drive through the Conner Creek Junction stop sign straight ahead 16 miles to Almo Idaho to the City of Rocks Visitor Center.

For Points West. Boise Take I-84 east. Take exit 216 for ID-25 toward Declo, Albion in .02 miles turn right onto ID-77. In 23 miles turn right onto S. Elba Almo Rd. 16 miles to the City of Rocks ranger station in Almo, Idaho.

You can reserve City of Rocks National Reserve and Castle Rocks State Park through Reserve America. Castle Rocks “Smokey Mountain RV park is \$29.00 per night and offers hookups and running water at the campsites. Restrooms and showers are available. Your nightly camping ticket allows you to enter Castle Rocks State Park.

Camping in the City of Rocks Reserve is \$13.00 per night. The park offers a pit toilet and water. There is no garbage pick up.

AMENITIES Tracy's County Store is the general store in Almo. www.tracysgeneralstore.com Large grocery stores can be found in Burley (an hour away). It is recommended that you do your food shopping in advance. Guidebooks, maps, and information are available at the visitor center in Almo. Cell phone signals are getting better but still spotty in the Area. phones may not work at the climbing area.

WEATHER & CLIMATE The City of Rocks is a high desert area, with climbs between 6000 -7000 feet in elevation. Thus, spring storms can bring wind, snow or rain, while summer temperatures can be in the 100 degrees F range during hot spells. When packing, please do not omit layers, as weather may change suddenly. The climbs are on a variety of aspects, so one can find or avoid the sun as necessary. Summer heat makes hydration a critical issue.
